NVQ Qualification Structures

Barbering African Type Hair – Level 2

Candidates must complete **7 mandatory units** plus a **minimum of 6 optional credits** to achieve the full qualification.

Mandatory Units (all must be completed)

- G20** Ensure responsibility for actions to reduce risks to health and safety (4 credits) (ENTO HSS 1)
- G4** Fulfil salon reception duties (3 credits)
- G15** Advise and consult with clients with African Type Hair (4 credits)
- G17** Give clients a positive impression of yourself and your organisation (5 credits) (ICS Unit 9)
- AH6** Shampoo and treat hair and scalp for African Type Hair (4 credits)
- AH19** Cut and shave facial hair to shape using basic techniques (4 credits)
- AH20** Cut, groom and finish African Type Hair using barbering techniques (8 credits)

PLUS a minimum of 6 optional credits from the list below:

- AH21** Create basic patterns in hair (4 credits)
- AH22** Texturise hair (6 credits)
- AH23** Style hair using twisting techniques (4 credits)
- H18** Provide scalp massage services (5 credits)
- G8** Develop and maintain your effectiveness at work (3 credits)
- G18** Promote additional services or products to clients (6 credits) (ICS Unit 10)
